

Guidelines for Ensuring the Safety of Students on School Bus and Nursery Van

1. Students must pack school bags as soon as possible when the dismissal starts.
Students must then go to the waiting area (covered playground or school hall) immediately.
2. Students must queue and be quiet while waiting for buses.
3. Students must board and alight from buses properly as directed. Pay attention to the passing vehicles if they need to cross the road.
4. Students must follow the instructions from nannies. Students must not talk to drivers or shout throughout the journey.
5. Students must be polite to schoolmates. They must sit according to the designated position, and do not change seats without permission.
6. Students must wear seat belts appropriately before buses move. Students must not unfasten or play with seat belts throughout the journey.
7. Students must keep the carriage clean and do not eat or litter.
8. Students must remain seated unless boarding or alighting. They must not board or alight while the bus is in motion.
9. Students must not put their heads, hands, or any part of their bodies out of the bus windows. They must not play with the emergency exits.
10. Students must pack all their personal belongings before alighting and stand clear from moving vehicles after alighting.
